Opt-In Availability


- If admitted or readmitted to UCF

 - provided the student has not enrolled in any campus-based class
- One time opt-in only

Appeals

- Students seeking to appeal their ineligibility for UCF Online may complete a petition form, which will be considered by the UCF Online Petition Committee
- Opt-Out Availability
 - One time opt-out only

Change of Major Process:

- For Opt-ins, Opt-outs, and those approved by the UCF Online Petition Committee
- Self-service "Change of Major" is not available for:
 - Conventional students wanting to switch to UCF Online, or
 - UCF Online student wanting to switch out of UCF Online
- The Academic Advisor in the student's program of study must complete a hard copy "Change of Major" form on the student's behalf; the RO will process the form.
